

COVID-19 Statement

Limiting Access to Essential Personnel Only

The operations of Bear Contracting and Bear Utilities fall under the category of ESSENTIAL INFRASTRUCTURE category in the Executive Order 9-20 issued by the Governor on 03/23/2020 and will continue unless otherwise directed by the project owner, inspector, or other governing authority.

At this time, all operations will continue using in accordance with the Governors orders using social distancing and other precautions recommended by the Harrison County Health Department and the CDC. Currently, our projects throughout the state of West Virginia, as well as operations outside of the state, are functioning and will continue as the federal government, state, and CDC allow.

Bear Contracting and Bear Utilities identifies “essential personnel” as an individual whose job duties are a necessity to the general operations, safety, and overall well-being of the company. Temporarily, Bear Contracting and Bear Utilities will be implementing a rotating staff schedule to minimize the number of individuals in the workplace. This measure will allow no more than 10 individuals in the office at a time. **Our office is currently closed to the public and open only to essential personnel during their scheduled time.** We are directing employees whose job duties allow it, to contact their supervisor and coordinate plans to temporarily work remotely effective immediately.
